

Today I read an interesting article from "Focus" Magazine brotherhood publication. The editor Jack Wilkie wrote about "Four Things Your Actions Teach Your Kids About the Church." The four points he makes are so true and are good to be reminded of:

- 1. Teach them the importance of the church by committing to attend.**
He talks about teaching them that attending services is a non-negotiable part of our lives. He says when we show them that attendance each week is "optional" and allow them to see secular activities taking the place of worship, we shouldn't be surprised when the church doesn't matter to them as they become independent and begin making their own decisions, our kids/grandkids are watching us!
- 2. Teach them what matters in a church by your choice of where to attend.** Brother Wilkie explains we must attend the church that has true biblical teaching and adheres to the New Testament pattern. They need to see a group of God's people who serve and love each other, and a group that loves God and His Word. Our kids/grandkids are watching us!
- 3. Teach them by our words how much we value our church family.** They need to hear us lifting up our church family, both in word and in our prayers, they need to see us valuing our church family, not gossiping or tearing each other down. Our kids/grandkids are watching us!
- 4. Teach them by your fellowship that the church is truly a family!** They need to see us spending time together, not just a few minutes on Sunday, but really making relationships, bearing each others burdens, sharing each others joys. Teach them we mean it when we say we are family! Our kids/grandkids are watching us!
