

## Would You Also Go Away?

"From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more. Then Jesus said to the twelve, 'Do you also want to go away?' But Simon Peter answered Him, 'Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life'" (John 6:66-68). Some of the saddest times in the life of Christ were when His disciples, even after he had performed miracles and fed and taught them, rejected Him. Their excuses for not believing in Him were many. Before they walked away on this occasion, their complaint was, "This is a hard saying; who can understand it?" (6:60). Today it is heart-breaking when we see those who, for whatever reason, leave the fellowship of the church and align themselves with unbelievers. They choose to follow their own opinions and feelings. Here is how Jesus described a group of people who were very religious and dedicated, but in error: "You make the commandments of God of no effect by your tradition. Hypocrites! Well did Isaiah prophesy about you, saying, 'These people draw near to Me with their mouth, and honor Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me. And in vain they worship Me, teaching as doctrines the commandments of men'" (Matthew 15:6-9). Jesus made it quite clear that He comes even before family: "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate (love less) his father and his mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters,, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple" (Luke 14:26). Some who desire to be popular allow their lives to be controlled by the majority. Jesus said: "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it" (Matthew 7:13-14). Every child of God should consider Peter's wise response: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life" (John 6:68).
