A Way That Seems Right

I recently read how Douglas Corrigan got his nickname. On July 17, 1938, he left Floyd Bennett Airfield on the east coast of the United States bound for Long Beach, California. He was flying his 1929 Curtis Robin monoplane with only two compasses as his navigational equipment. Twenty-nine hours later he landed in Dublin, Ireland. Until his death in Long Beach in 1995 he was always known as "Wrong Way Corrigan." I'm rather certain Corrigan would agree that it makes a difference how reliable our guide is, and how closely we follow it.

The Bible is our only guide from earth to Heaven. Many today are confused and are asking the same question Thomas asked: "How can we know the way?" Jesus answered: "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me" (John 14:56). Jesus told His apostles that He would send the comforter to them. "When He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth" (John 16:13). Peter wrote that "holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit" (2 Peter 1:20).

We have the Bible, the word inspired by the Holy Spirit, as our guide to all truth. We do not need, nor should we accept, any latter-day revelations because we already have all truth! Paul said, "But even if we or an angel from heaven preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed" (Galatians 1:8-9).

Peter wrote, "There will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies . . . and many will follow their destructive ways" (2 Peter 1:1-2).
