NO GOOD DEED GOES UNPUNISHED

"I have shown you many good works from the Father; for which of them are you going to stone Me?" (John 10:32)

We teach our children to do right and promise them that when they do right good things will happen. This may be true as a general rule; but it is not an absolute truth. Sometimes in our sin-filled world it seems that "no good deed goes unpunished." We must be prepared for the possibility of suffering when doing good (1 Peter 2:20; 3:17; & 4:19).

If we suffer for doing good, we must realize that we are in good company. The more good Jesus did, the more He was opposed. It was the healing of a crippled man that led the Pharisees to seek to take His life (Matthew 12:14). And as John 10:32 indicates, the more His deeds pointed Him out as the Son of God, the more they hated Him.

We also are to be children of God. We do not stand in the unique relationship Jesus had; but we also will feel the anger of the world as we draw closer to our Heavenly Father. Remember the warning of Jesus: "A servant is not greater than his master; if they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you" (John 15:20).
