A few years ago we visited with a man who helped design a life-size robot of Abraham Lincoln. Not only did it look realistic, but it could even stand up and make a speech.

The designer showed us the schematics of its inner workings – a true marvel of human intelligence and engineering. The designer made the robot, but God made the designer. And what a design it is! As David said, "I am fearfully and wonderfully made" (Psalm 139:14). Using his God-given faculties, David was able to sling a stone with precision, play the harp with skill, and contemplate his Creator.
