Make the Most of Opportunities

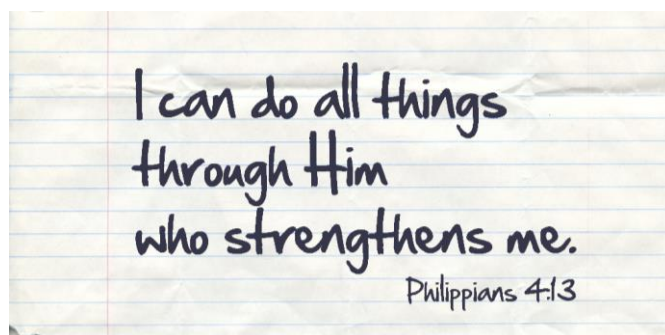
America has been called the land of opportunity. Opportunity has great motivational potential. In the business world; when "opportunity knocks," the thrifty, successful businessman makes the most of it. Yet, in the spiritual realm, many opportunities come and go – often wasted or unnoticed. While human weakness is largely to blame, many of our unused opportunities are the result of our own complacency toward the lost. Here are some suggestions to help us make greater use of our opportunities:

First, we must pray for opportunities. God answers prayer. As we use the opportunities God has given, He will provide even greater opportunities (Matthew 25:29).
