Courage

The Bible is full of characters who demonstrate an immense amount of courage, those who were willing to place their very lives in danger to save others. It is a dangerous game to tell a king he is in the wrong, but when David had strayed from the path of righteousness, Nathan told him about his error (2 Samuel 12). To go before the King of Persia without being summoned carried a possible death sentence if he did not accept the visitor, but Queen Esther risked her life to save her people from slaughter (Esther 5). In His life, Jesus dared to call out the hypocrisy of religious leaders (Matthew 15:1-9), as well as to freely surrender His life for us (John 10:17-18). As we encounter difficult situations and tough choices throughout our lives, let us aspire to show the same courage as these we've mentioned and other biblical characters, too.
